### Dialog 1

- W: Hey, Mark. Guess what?  
M: What?  
W: I'm running in a marathon next month.  
M: Wow, that's great! I didn't know you liked running.  
W: Yeah, I just started a couple of months ago.  
M: And you're running in a marathon? Which one? The one in Gifu?  
W: No, the one in Shizuoka.  
M: Shouldn't you be running something a bit shorter?

- W: Like what?
- M: Like a half-marathon. There's one in Mie in a couple of weeks.
- W: Yeah, I'm busy that week. But I did think about it.
- M: Okay. There's also a half-marathon coming up this weekend in Toyota. There's still time to sign up. You should think about it. Start small.
- W: You're right. But the one I'm doing is a team marathon. I'm doing it with four other runners. Each of us only has to run about 8 kilometers.
- M: Oh, I see. Well, that sounds perfect then.

### Passage 1

Good evening. This is Sophie McIntyre with the London weather. Today was quite cold and breezy, with a high of 13 degrees and a low of 8. On Monday and Tuesday, London will warm up significantly, and we will see a high of around 22. This is 9 degrees warmer than the average 13<sup>space</sup>degrees we usually see at this time of year.

However, the Weather Bureau has cautioned that London's weather will change quite dramatically on Thursday. It will become windy and rather cloudy, but with only a little chance of rain. Temperatures will fall steeply with a high of 6 during the day. The night will be cold, with temperatures falling to -1. On Friday, there may be snow in some areas. That's it for now. Please check our website for the latest updates on London weather.

**Passage 2**

W: Dave, you bought a new printer last month, didn't you? Maybe you can help me out.

M: Sure, what do you want to know?

W: Well, I want to buy a printer, too. And I was wondering what kind you bought.

M: I got a laser printer.

W: Oh yeah? How come?

M: It's really fast and good for printing documents. So if you need to print a lot of documents, you might want to get a printer like mine.

W: Yeah, I'll mostly use it to print documents. But I also want to print out pictures.

M: In that case, you might want to get an inkjet printer instead.

W: A what?

M: Inkjet. They're very affordable these days. They're also better for printing high quality color pictures. I'd recommend that. Mine wouldn't be good for that because it's just a black and white printer.

W: Only black and white?

M: Yep. There are color laser printers, too, but they're a bit pricey. Oh, and if you really want to spend a lot of money, you could even get an all-in-one printer which comes with a scanner.

W: Hmm...is there anything else I should think about?

M: Yeah, go wireless. I mean, you don't need all those cables.

W: Okay. I'll do that. I don't think I'll get a printer like yours, though. You know,



printing photos is really important for me, but the color laser printer's probably too expensive, so I'll get an inkjet.

M: Have you thought about where to buy one?

W: I'm not really sure. I have a Mac computer, so I thought I could just go to the Apple Store and get the printer there.

M: You know, I don't even think they sell printers.

W: Oh, really?

M: Yeah, and even if they do, they're probably expensive.

W: I saw an advertisement the other day for printers at Johnson's Electronics store. But they only sell used stuff, right?

M: Yeah, but I wouldn't get a used printer. It's better instead to get a new one. Why don't you try ABC Electronics? They always have a great selection to choose from, and the sales people are really helpful, too. Oh, and another place you could try is Future Shop. It's an online store.

W: Yeah, that's what I'll do. That way I won't have to carry the printer home on the train. Thanks, Dave! I really appreciate your help.

### Passage 3

W: Welcome to Sky Tours. How may I help you today?

M: I'd like to book a round-trip flight to Madrid in October.

W: Okay, do you have any specific dates in mind?

- M: Well, I have to attend a conference on the 12th and 13th, so I'd like to arrive there on the 11th and then leave on the 15th, if possible.
- W: Okay, do you want to fly out of Nagoya?
- M: Yeah, that'd be great.
- W: Let me see ... there's a flight leaving Nagoya on the 11th. Coming back you would leave Madrid on the 15th, but you'd arrive here in Japan on the 16th. Tickets are 200,000 yen.
- M: That's a little expensive. I was hoping for something under 150,000 yen.
- W: Well, there's a flight out of Narita for 120,000 yen.
- M: That's much cheaper. Are the dates the same?
- W: No. Coming back, you'd have to leave at night on the 13th, and you'd arrive back in Japan on the 14th.
- M: Does the price include the flight from Nagoya to Narita?
- W: No ... that would cost ... another 20,000 yen.
- M: Yeah, you know, I'd rather fly out of Nagoya than Narita. What if I changed the dates and arrived a day earlier in Madrid? Would that change the cost?
- W: Just a moment. Let me see if there are any flights available. Oh, okay. Here's one. It leaves Nagoya on the 10th and arrives in Madrid on the 11th. The return flight leaves Madrid on the 14th, arriving in Nagoya the next day. This flight would cost 150,000 yen.
- M: Yeah, but that doesn't give me much time to see the city.
- W: You could also leave Nagoya one day earlier on the 9th. You would arrive in Madrid on the 10th. The price would be the same.
- M: Oh, okay, I'd like to reserve that flight. I'll see the city first and then attend the

conference later.

W: Okay, I'll go ahead and make your reservation. Could you give me your name, please?

**Passage 4**

W: Welcome to Pacific Sports Club! Could I have your membership card, please?

M: Actually, this is my first time here. I'm thinking of becoming a member.

W: Okay, are you familiar with our different membership plans?

M: No, not really.

W: Oh, I see. Well, let me explain them to you, then. We have four plans: bronze, silver, gold, and platinum. Our basic plan is the bronze membership, which can be used from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on weekdays only. And then we have our silver membership, which can be used seven days a week from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The gold membership offers 24-hour access, Monday through Friday. And our top plan is the platinum membership, which offers 24-hour access every day of the week to all our facilities.

M: I see. How much does each membership plan cost?

W: It's 4,000 yen for the bronze, 6,000 yen for the silver, 10,000 yen for the gold, and 12,000 yen for our top plan, the platinum. These fees are to be paid monthly.

M: What's your most popular membership plan?

W: Well, students usually choose bronze because it's the cheapest. However, the majority of our members prefer being able to come whenever they want. So most of our members choose the top plan. Some office workers prefer the gold plan while many senior citizens choose the silver plan.

M: Okay. Well, since I'm a student as well, I'd like to sign up for your most economical plan.

W: Great! If you could just fill out this form, I'll get you started.
