研究課題: A mixed-methods study on 'internationalization at home'

During this study-abroad term I focused on a mixed-methods study to examine the ways that Thai tutors, who are participating as ambassador hosts to visiting groups of overseas students during short-term study-abroad programs, develop their intercultural competence within their native Thai environment. The main focus of this study was as follows: To what extent do Thai tutors develop their intercultural competence as ambassador hosts within their local 'at home' context during short-term study abroad programs with visiting overseas students?

Unfortunately, it was not possible to travel to my intended destination of Khon Kaen, Thailand during this study-abroad term due to the global pandemic. Instead, I was invited to become a visiting research scholar under the guidance of Dr. Jiro Takai, who is a Professor and Dean in the Graduate School of Education and Human Development at Nagoya University, from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021. Dr. Takai provided guidance in the area of intercultural competence background research and methodology for my project. I also conducted online research through collaboration with Professor Prawpun Pholboon (who has served as a liaison for several years with the Nanzan Asia Program in Thailand) at Nanzan University's partner school of Khon Kaen University in Khon Kaen, Thailand.

Research results to date on this study-abroad project are summarized below. Given the central importance of intercultural competence development in the study-abroad context, I am confident that this study has and will add positively to the body of research. Additionally, Dr. Takai has encouraged me to pursue a doctorate degree, which I intend to do, at Nagoya University from April, 2022. I sincerely wish to thank Nanzan University for this generous opportunity to conduct this research during my one-year study-abroad term.
